Berlitz evaluates students based on levels (1-10). The Berlitz Proficiency Levels have been used for decades and are recognized by such institutions as the American Council on Education, the Defense Language Institute, the Foreign Service Institute, and the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages. Students are tested in speaking, listening, reading and writing skills to assess comprehension, grammar, spelling, vocabulary, pronunciation, writing, and speaking ability (Berlitz, 2004).
